

LETTER FROM PASTOR KURT

Greetings in the name of the Lord,

Five years ago, God gave me a vision to reach the city of Greeley and the surrounding areas with His love. The Lord showed me individual faces He wanted to draw to Himself through our ministry. Our why was simple; partner with the Holy Spirit to provide a place where these precious people could find faith in Jesus. We had our why and knew where, but how exactly should we build?

In a nutshell, we build with three objectives: **Encounter**, **Empower**, and **Shine**.

- **#1. We Encounter God** Our premier value is to love God passionately and to encounter His presence through praise and worship.
- **#2. We Empower People** Before God's children can radiate His love, they must be transformed, equipped, and stirred up in their faith.
- **#3. We Shine God's Love** Jesus didn't call us to just go to a church; He called us to become the church that shines His love everywhere we go. He called us to light up our world!

We had our simple marching orders, but then God gave me a detailed blueprint. City Lights Church has been and will always be the Lord's church; however, as the Lead Pastor, I must take the responsibility to seek the Lord on how He would have us continue to build. One day as I was reading the book of Nehemiah, the Lord highlighted a strategy to build a Holy Spirit-empowered, life-giving church. Nehemiah was called to rebuild the torn-down walls of Jerusalem. The Holy Spirit revealed to me the 10 gates to be rebuilt in chapter 3 were purposely and prophetically named. The Lord showed me that the gates are a prototype of how He wants to build His church. Housed in the center of the city walls of Jerusalem was the temple. The temple was the place where the presence of God dwelt. In the New Covenant, God declared through the Apostle Paul that He desires to dwell within the assembly of His followers.

Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of His household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus Himself as the chief cornerstone. In Him, the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. And in Him, you, too, are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by His Spirit. – Ephesians 2:19-22 NIV

It is not a temple of stone that the Apostle refers to but a brotherhood and sisterhood of believers that God desires to live among.

The Lord showed me that His presence should be surrounded by and will thrive within these prophetic gates of revival.

Let me give you a brief synopsis of their names and prophetic significance:

- 1. The Sheep Gate We must provide a place where the sheep (God's flock) will gather and grow.
- 2. The Fish Gate Jesus said to the disciples I will make you fishers of men. We must be a church that evangelizes.
- **3.** The Old Gate With age comes wisdom. We must help young believers mature in their faith. We must make disciples of Jesus.
- **4.** The Valley Gate Valleys are the low places. We must be a church that can minister to those coming through deep dark places. We must help them exchange beauty for their ashes.
- **5.** The Dung Gate (Deliverance Gate) We must help people heal from yesterday so they can have hope for tomorrow.
- **6. The Fountain Gate** Flowing water represents the Holy Spirit. We must be a church that flows in the gifts and ministries of the Holy Spirit.
- **7. The Water Gate** Water represents the word of God. We must be a church that preaches the Holy Bible.
- **8.** The Horse Gate In the Bible, horses were war animals. We must be a church that fights and wins spiritual battles in heavenly realms.
- **9.** The East Gate The East Gate is the Bible prophecy gate. One day Jesus will visibly and physically return to the Earth and pass through the East Gate, where He will rule and reign. We must be a church that is waiting and watching for His return.
- **10. The Inspection Gate** Inspection is an essential part of the Christian life. One day we will stand before the rewarder's seat of Christ. To be ready for this final inspection, we must inspect ourselves and call the gold out of each other in an authentic community.

As we keep these prophetic gates wide open, I believe that we will truly experience a rich dwelling for His presence.

I pray that each City Lights member sees themself as a gatekeeper. Gatekeepers do not just causally attend; they are invested in and share in the responsibility of their faith community.

Will you help us keep the gates of revival open to our city and our world?







2022 ATTENDANCE










2022 GIVING CHART
